
## **Cottage Grove History**

- 1 London area mines sought quicksilver which is also known by this name.
- 3 East Cottage Grove adopted this name when they succeeded from Cottage Grove.
- 5 Brought electricity to Cottage Grove in 1894.
- 6 This oldest local schoolhouse was closed down at the end of the 2019 school year.
- 7 Nickname given to West Cottage Grove during the feud years.
- 10 Timber family that built the Village Green



## Across

- 2 This precious mineral, found in the hills and streams help build the town of Cottage Grove.
- 4 Town that once existed where Cottage Grove Lake now sits.
- 8 Established in 1842, this wagon trail was also known as the Southern Route.
- 9 Once known as Hunt Falls this popular waterfall was an annual gathering place for early tribes.
- 11 Originally built in 1925, this railroad bridge no longer has real tracks.
- 12 This river runs through town along River Road.
- 13 This once abundant tuber was cultivated by Native Americans in the Willamette Valley and was an important food resource.
